I have been working as a Senior Consultant in the Cardiology Department of Heraklion University General Hospital. I was elected Associate Professor of Cardiology at the University of Crete Medical School in September 2022.

My clinical work currently includes:

- Daily ward rounds in the Cardiology Wards and Acute Cardiac Care Unit
- Weekly transthoracic echocardiography clinic
- Weekly transoesophageal and stress echocardiography clinic
- Weekly out-patient hypertension clinic
- Weekly out-patient heart failure and cardiomyopathies clinic
 - Weekly out-patient cardio-oncology clinic

Administrative responsibility includes directing out-patient hypertension and heart failure clinic. I have organized within the Medical School and I am the Head of the research laboratory of Molecular Cardiology.

I contributed to numerous research projects regarding experimental models of renindependent, salt-dependent and hyperadrenergic mechanisms of hypertension and in non-enzymatic properties of the angiotensin-converting enzyme. I also participated in studies investigating molecular mechanisms, inflammatory factors and oxidative stress in the field of hypertension and cardiomyopathy.

My current research focuses on the secondary prevention of cardiovascular disease, pathogenesis and treatment of hypertension, atherosclerosis and thrombosis, while my laboratory group is evaluating the identification of molecular markers and

transcriptome in relation to the genesis of cardiovascular diseases. I am also very actively involved in applications of data science in hypertension and heart failure.

From all posts I have emphasized the importance of bridging disciplines from basic science to clinical practice. My main goal is prioritising patient-centered domains into clinical care and research and improving patients' prognosis and outcome.

I have authored more than 115 peer-reviewed articles in Pubmed (h-index scopus 28, citations: 12523).

I have an active role in improving and offering a broad spectrum of educational opportunities for the cardiologists in Greece. I was also involved in the organization of several regional, national and international conferences and seminars.

During the Covid-19 pandemic, I participated as an invited speaker in several Webinars and TV documentaries about the impact of Sars- CoV2 on hypertension and cardiovascular diseases.

I am a fellow of European Society of Cardiology (FESC) and a Hypertension Specialist (European Society of Hypertension).

I am also actively involved in Undergraduate and Graduate teaching at the University of Crete Medical School. I am the President of the Working Group of Essential Hypertension of the Hellenic Society of Cardiology. I am also a member of the European Society of Cardiology Committee for the European Examination of General Cardiology (EEGC) and a member of the Digital Health Committee of the European Society of Cardiology.
